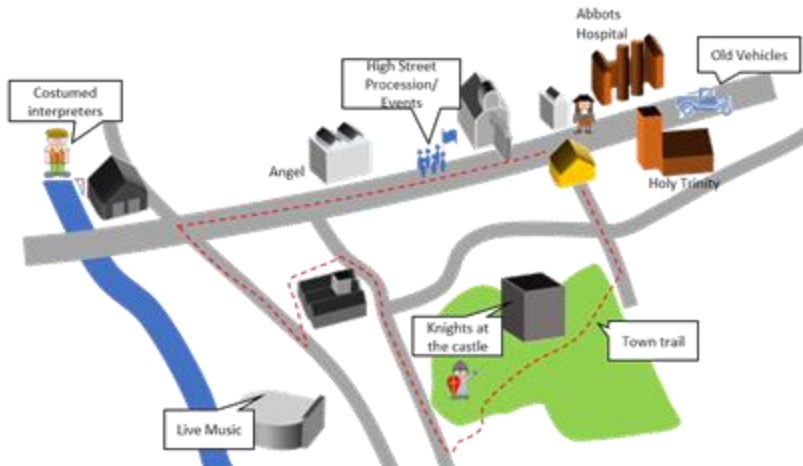


# “Have fun with History” event
